



# California Health Benefits Review Program:

## Academic Rigor on a Legislative Timeline

The California Health Benefits Review Program (CHBRP) leverages faculty and researchers from the University of California to provide the Legislature timely, independent, and rigorous evidence-based analyses of introduced health insurance benefits-related legislation. Frequently, CHBRP analyzes proposed health insurance benefit mandates (i.e. requirements to cover a test, treatment, or service).

### CORE COMPONENTS OF CHBRP ANALYSES



#### Policy Context

- Whose health insurance would have to comply?
- Are related laws already in effect?



#### Medical Effectiveness

- What services / treatments are most relevant?
- Does evidence indicate impact on outcomes?



#### Cost

- Would benefit coverage, utilization, or cost change?



#### Public Health

- How would the bill affect population-level health?
